*Under the supervision of Cal Performances' Stage Supervisors, Event Managers, designated Scene Technicians, or designated touring personnel: assist in the installation of elements of the various theatrical stagecraft areas (lighting, sound, scenery, rigging, props, etc.) for the realization of events in Cal Performances' venues.

*Assists full crew in one or more of the following tasks:

- Unload/load trucks
- Set-up/strike staging and/or scenic elements
- Arrange stage equipment
- Perform maintenance functions
- Practice safe working habits
- Run production related errands

*Under the general supervision of production management or designates, Assistant Scene Technicians assist in planned maintenance projects or other non-theatrical events.
