

CAL PERFORMANCES AT UC BERKELEY PRESENTS RIOULT DANCE NY IN BACH DANCES SATURDAY-SUNDAY, MAY 6-7, 2017 ADDED PERFORMANCES!

Berkeley, March 17, 2017 — Cal Performances welcomes back **RIOULT Dance NY** for Bach Dances, a program of works by founder and choreographer Pascal Rioult set to the music of Johann Sebastian Bach, on Saturday, May 6 at 2pm and 8pm and Sunday, May 7 at 3pm and 7pm in Zellerbach Playhouse. The French-born Rioult, who founded his company in New York more than 20 years ago, is celebrated for carrying on the legacies of his early mentors, Martha Graham and May O'Donnell, in his emotive and elegant works. Bach Dances includes four Rioult dances created over a span of seven years—Views of the Fleeting World (2008), City (2010), Celestial Tides (2011), and Polymorphous (2015)—each putting Bach's Baroque musical masterpieces in conversation with scenic design and visual imagery made possible by 21st century technology.

Views of the Fleeting World, set to Bach's The Art of Fugue, is inspired by the ancient woodblock prints of the Japanese master Hiroshige, as well as the crystalline structure of Bach's musical score. The work is divided into nine short vignettes—"Orchard," "Gathering Storm," "Wild Horses," "Dusk, Rain," "Night Ride," "Summer Wind," "Moonlight," and "Flowing River"—each reflecting on the simplicity and emotional weight of a single image. City is danced to Bach's Sonata for Violin and Harpsichord No. 6 in G Major, and features projections of buildings that progressively deconstruct and distort, exploring the humanity of individuals in a potentially alienating urban environment. Celestial Tides is a work of abstract movement derived from the structure and tone of Bach's Brandenburg Concerto No. 6. The dance features a memorable double duet for two women and two men, in which each couple explores a broad emotional landscape with a sense of tenderness and curiosity. Finally, Polymorphous probes the subjectivity of perception through movement and technology, with music from The Well Tempered Clavier.

About RIOULT Dance NY

Founded in 1994, <u>RIOULT Dance NY</u> is committed to supporting the creation of new works by founder and choreographer, Pascal Rioult. The New York City-based dance company presents an annual New York season, tours nationally and internationally, conducts extensive in-school arts education and community outreach programs, and offers dance training to the public through classes, workshops, and intensives. RIOULT Dance NY has performed in theaters and festivals throughout North America, as well as at international dance festivals and performing arts venues. Since the company's inception, Pascal Rioult has created more than 40 dances, presented 20 New York seasons, toured Europe and North America, and has employed more than 30 dancers.

Cal Performances is the performing arts presenter and producer of the University of California, Berkeley, fulfilling its mission by presenting, producing, and commissioning renowned and emerging artists in music, dance, and theater.
