**Berkeley, December 4, 2024**—Cal Performances and the Graduate Division at UC Berkeley present historian and political commentator Heather Cox Richardson in conversation with UC Berkeley professor of law and history Dylan Penningroth for a timely discussion about the reshaping of the United States' two major political parties. A professor of 19th century American history at Boston College, Richardson provides an incisive perspective on current politics to the more than three million readers of her nightly newsletter, *Letters from an American*. She has written for the *Washington Post*, the *New York Times*, and the *Guardian*, and is the author, most recently, of the best-selling book *Democracy Awakening: Notes on the State of* 

*America*. Penningroth is the author of the award-winning *Before the Movement: The Hidden History of Black Civil Rights*. He serves as Associate Dean of the Program in Jurisprudence and Social Policy at the UC Berkeley Law School; his scholarship focuses on African American and legal history.
