Berkeley, CA, October 24, 2025—Cal Performances at UC Berkeley announces the cancellation of its presentation of *Sutra*, a collaboration of Belgian choreographer Sidi Larbi Cherkaoui, British visual artist Antony Gormley, Polish composer Szymon Brzóska, and the Monks of the Shaolin Temple that was planned to take place on Saturday, November 8 at 8pm and Sunday, November 9 at 3pm at Zellerbach Hall. The entire US tour of the Sadler's Wells and Shaolin Temple Production of *Sutra*, including their engagement at Cal Performances, has been canceled due to injuries recently sustained by central members of the cast.
