CAL PERFORMANCES AT UC BERKELEY PRESENTS VIOLINIST TESSA LARK AND PIANIST ANDREW ARMSTRONG IN CAL PERFORMANCES AT HOME, A NEW PERFORMING ARTS STREAMING SERIES THURSDAY, OCTOBER 1 AT 7PM (PDT)

First performance in the fall 2020 streaming series, which features a premiere each week, October 1, 2020 through January 14, 2021

Berkeley, September 10, 2020 — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley presents violinist Tessa Lark and pianist Andrew Armstrong in a virtual recital premiere that will begin streaming on Thursday, October 1 at 7pm (PDT). The performance is the first of 16 new, professionally produced full-length performances in the recently announced performing arts streaming series *Cal Performances at Home*. A new performance will premiere each week beginning October 1, 2020 and continuing through January 14, 2021. On the evenings of each streaming premiere, a special digital "watch party" will feature a participatory live chat element. WHO

Kentucky native Tessa Lark grew up with both classical music and fiddle tunes in her ears, and has been known to cap a classical violin recital with an encore selection that invokes her bluegrass roots. In 2012, Lark became the first American since 1960 to win the Walter M. Naumburg International Violin Competition; since then, she has since gone on to receive further honors, including the prestigious Avery Fisher Career Grant. *Gramophone* has applauded Lark's "canny ability to adjust her approach according to the stylistic dictates of whatever she's playing." Here, in this online streaming recital with pianist Andrew Armstrong in New York City's Merkin Hall, Lark presents an eclectic program infused with folk sounds from Northern and Eastern Europe, and featuring Schubert's transcendent Fantasy in C major.
