**Berkeley, February 17, 2021** — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley presents pianist Mitsuko Uchida in a virtual recital, streamed online in a digital watch party accompanied by a participatory live chat on Thursday, March 18 at 7pm (PDT). Following its debut, Mitsuko Uchida's performance will be available for viewing on demand through June 16, 2021. Her recital is one of 12 newly produced, full-length performances in the Spring 2021 *Cal Performances at Home* performing arts streaming series, a continuation of the ambitious series launched in fall 2020. Filmed on stages all over the world—in renowned venues and recording studios in the locations where the artists are sheltering in place—all artists in the spring series were originally booked to perform in person at UC Berkeley as part of Cal Performances' 2020–21 live season, which was cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic. Spring performances will debut on select Thursday evenings through June 10, 2021 as digital watch parties accompanied by participatory live chats. Every performance (except where noted) will be viewable on demand for three months following its debut. **WHO** Pianist Mitsuko Uchida is a revered interpreter of Schubert. In this recital, recorded for *Cal Performances at Home* at London's Wigmore Hall, she performs a program dedicated to the composer's stirring piano music, featuring two Impromptus and the transcendent Sonata in G major.
