MASTER OF SATIRE <u>DAVID SEDARIS</u> RETURNS TO CAL PERFORMANCES WITH HIS LASTEST COLLECTION OF ESSAYS SUNDAY, APRIL 26

BERKELEY, October 29, 2008—American humorist David Sedaris returns to Cal Performances Sunday, April 26, 2009, at 8:00 p.m. in Zellerbach Hall. Sedaris, who "just may be the funniest man alive" (*Time Out New York*), will read from his new collection of personal essays, titled *When You Are Engulfed in Flames* (June 2008), his sixth book and a *New York Times* Best Seller. Sedaris uses his razor-sharp wit to detail some of life's most bizarre and awkward moments, including his decision to quit smoking.

Sedaris may well be the closest thing the literary world has these days to a rock star—his speaking engagements are consistently standing-room-only, a far cry from his early days as a housecleaner in New York City. Sedaris made his comic debut recounting his strange-but-true experiences of his job as a Macy's elf clad in green tights, reading his *SantaLand Diaries* on National Public Radio's Morning Edition. The great skill with which Sedaris slices through cultural euphemisms and political correctness proves that he is a master of satire and one of the most observant writers addressing the human condition today.

Sedaris is the author of the bestsellers *Barrel Fever* and *Holidays on Ice*, as well as collections of personal essays, *Naked* and *Me Talk Pretty One Day*, both of which became immediate bestsellers. Sedaris and his sister, Amy Sedaris, have collaborated under the name "The Talent Family" and have written several plays which have been produced at La Mama, Lincoln Center, and The Drama Department in New York City. These plays include *Stump the Host, Stitches, One Woman Shoe*, which received an Obie Award, *Incident at Cobbler's Knob*, and *The Book of Liz*, which was published in book form by Dramatist's Play Service. His essays appear regularly in *Esquire* and *The New Yorker*.

Sedaris's original radio pieces can often be heard on *This American Life*, distributed nationally by Public Radio International and produced by WBEZ in Chicago. In 2001, he became the third recipient of the Thurber Prize for American Humor. He was named "Humorist of the Year" by Time magazine in 2001. His book *Dress Your Family in Corduroy and Denim* was published in June 2004, and an anthology of stories, *Children Playing Before a Statue of Hercules: An Anthology of Outstanding Stories*, edited by Sedaris, was published in April 2005. In 2005, he was nominated for two Grammy Awards for Best Spoken Word Album (*Dress Your Family in Corduroy & Denim*) and Best Comedy Album (*David Sedaris: Live at Carnegie Hall*).
