## CAL PERFORMANCES AT UC BERKELEY ANNOUNCES

## VIENNA BOYS CHOIR CONCERT ON NOVEMBER 27 IN ZELLERBACH HALL IS CANCELLED

## REFUNDS AND EXCHANGES ARE AVAILABLE FOR TICKET HOLDERS

Berkeley, September 10, 2021 — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley announces that the Vienna Boys Choir has cancelled its appearance at Zellerbach Hall on November 27, as part of the group's decision to cancel all touring activities, local and international, for the remainder of 2021. Due to the increased restrictions imposed by international authorities and the continued uncertainty surrounding international travel and the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the directors of the choir's school and the board of the Vienna Boys Choir have determined that the safety and well-being of the children must remain their primary focus. Efforts are underway to reschedule the group's appearance for Cal Performances' 2022–23 season.

Ticket holders may exchange tickets for another performance, donate the cost of their tickets as a tax-deductible gift to Cal Performances, or request a refund. If the Ticket Office does not hear from patrons by Friday, September 24 at 5pm regarding an exchange or donation, refunds will automatically be issued within 7–10 days.
