Berkeley, October 11, 2021 — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley presents Ballet Hispánico on Saturday, November 6 at 8pm in Zellerbach Hall. The performance celebrates the company’s 50th-anniversary and will feature works by an intergenerational cadre of choreographers who have been part of the company’s 50-year history. Vicente Nebrada’s *Arabesque* is an elegant suite of lush balletic contemporary dances with traces of Flamenco. Gustavo Ramírez Sansano created *18+1* to celebrate his personal career milestone of making work for 18 years, his choreography inspired by the mambo music of Pérez Prado. Annabelle Lopez Ochoa’s *Tiburones* addresses the discrimination and stereotypes placed upon Latinx culture, and the role the media plays in diminishing the voices of Latinx artists
