Berkeley, January 7, 2022 — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley welcomes back the university's ensemble-in-residence, **Eco Ensemble**, in a concert showcasing the music of **Toshio Hosokawa**, one of Japan's pre-eminent living composers, on Saturday, February 5 at 8pm at Hertz Hall. The contemporary chamber music ensemble, directed by music department faculty member David Milnes, will be joined by flute virtuoso Stacey Pelinka of the Left Coast Chamber Ensemble for a concert that reflects the composer's interest in traditional Japanese arts such as calligraphy and *gagaku* as sources of musical inspiration. Toshio Hosokawa will be a guest of the music department in Fall 2022 as the distinguished Bloch Lecturer.
