IN THE FINAL EVENT OF ITS 2021-22 IN-PERSON SEASON CAL PERFORMANCES AT UC BERKELEY PRESENTS LILA DOWNS SATURDAY, MAY 7 AT 8PM AT ZELLERBACH HALL

Berkeley, April 22, 2022 — Cal Performances at UC Berkeley presents Mexican American singer and activist Lila Downs on Saturday, May 7 at 8pm at Zellerbach Hall. Over the course of her 25-year career, Downs has earned multiple Grammy and Latin Grammy Awards and she is "no stranger to raising hell and consciousness through the power of song" (Rolling Stone). Her latest release, Al Chile (2019), is infused with the rhythms of cumbia and explores themes of pleasure and pain, suffering and redemption, through the metaphor of Mexico's ubiquitous chili pepper. For this final event of Cal Performances' 2021–22 in-person season, Downs will sing—in English, Spanish, and indigenous languages—her own compositions as well as those of others represented in her trademark genre-hopping repertoire. Her seven-piece ensemble accompanies her on accordion, jarana, zapateado, trumpet, trombone, guitar, bass, drums, and percussion.
