CAL PERFORMANCES AT UC BERKELEY PRESENTS MARK MORRIS DANCE GROUP IN THE BAY AREA PREMIERE OF THE LOOK OF LOVE AN EVENING OF DANCE TO THE MUSIC OF BURT BACHARACH AT ZELLERBACH HALL FRIDAY-SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 17–19

Berkeley, CA, January 23, 2023—Cal Performances at UC Berkeley welcomes back longtime collaborator and artistic partner the **Mark Morris Dance Group** in the Bay Area premiere of Morris' latest creation, *The Look of Love: An Evening of Dance to the Music of Burt Bacharach*, with three performances taking place on Friday and Saturday, February 17–18 at 8pm, and Sunday, February 19 at 3pm at Zellerbach Hall. The company has been visiting Berkeley annually (with a brief pandemic hiatus) to perform at Zellerbach Hall for more than 30 years, and in those decades has presented numerous premieres and commissions. *The Look of Love* follows the success of Morris' Beatles

tribute production *Pepperland*, which had its Bay Area premiere in the 2018–19 Cal Performances season.

For *The Look of Love*, Morris again partners with pianist/arranger **Ethan Iverson**, his musical collaborator from *Pepperland*, to create an homage to the popular and influential songs of Burt Bacharach. A towering figure through decades of popular music, Bacharach is known for catchy, clever melodies embedded in unique orchestrations influenced by jazz, rock, and Brazilian music. Bacharach's longtime lyricist Hal David sets a bittersweet tone with characteristically poignant, unsentimental lyrics. The production includes more than a dozen songs—both chart-topping hits and lesser-known tunes—by Bacharach that probe the complexities of romantic relationships, from hope to despair, from the thrill of romance to the pain of loss. Selections include "Walk on By," "I Say a Little Prayer," "Do You Know the Way to San Jose," "What the World Needs Now," "Alfie," "T'll Never Fall in Love Again," and "Raindrops Keep Fallin' on My Head."

Of the collaboration Morris shared that, "The idea came from Ethan Iverson, who years ago was music director of my company and who remains a brilliant jazz musician, writer, and friend. Long before we did *Pepperland* together, he wanted me to consider choreographing to Burt Bacharach's music...I love this music and so it came about quite naturally."

Iverson expounded, "I always loved the way Mark responds to text, meaning lyrics. Of course, many of his biggest successes—like *L'Allegro, il Penseroso ed il Moderato* and *Dido and Aeneas*—deal with text, but there's also something like the magnificent *Going Away Party* to country and western ballads from Bob Willis. Hal David's lyrics to Bacharach are phenomenal. Although this is heresy, it was easy for me to imagine certain moves Mark might do to David's text. Also, Mark is very sophisticated. He reads a musical score well and can work with hard meters and melodies. While some might consider

Bacharach a "light" composer, it turns out that, under the hood he is marvelously sophisticated. The songs are intricate but also catchy—which might be the hardest thing to do in music."

For this new evening-length production, Iverson's arrangements are performed live by an ensemble featuring Iverson on piano; Jonathan Finlayson (a Berkeley High School alumnus) on trumpet; Simón Willson on bass; and Vinny Sperrazza on drums; with singer, actress, and Broadway star Marcy Harriell on lead vocals, supported by backing singers Clinton Curtis and Blaire Reinhard. Nicole Pearce is the lighting designer and the production's bright and playful costumes were created by Isaac Mizrahi.
